#### **City Text Message Notification System**

The current Constant Contact vendor used for the City Update does offer texting as an option, but after thoroughly exploring the platform and talking with internal staff, we have decided to explore an easier solution. ## **City Council Meeting Recap** January 6, 2025 Meeting

- Accepted donations of \$200 from Jeffrey and Stephanie Anderson and \$100 from Shirley Frembgen for the Hastings Fire Department.
- Appointed Bryan Braun and Ryan Sherry to the Public Safety Advisory Commission.
- Accepted the Public Safety Advisory Commission 2024 Annual Report.
- Authorized submittal of the 2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) budget to Dakota County. The estimated funding of \$44,879 would be allocated towards local assessment abatement for qualified homeowners.
- City Administrator Dan Wietecha presented the PFAS Update with no significant changes since the last report but encouraged residents to visit the city website for PFAS information and updates.
- Discussed the city's membership in the Red Rock Corridor and Great River Rail Joint Powers Agreements.
