- Accepted a \$825 donation from Minnesota Jaycees Charitable Foundation to the Fire Department.
- Accepted donation of \$1,000 from the Miesville Lions Club to purchase ballistic vests for Reserves.
- Appointed Chelsea Piskor to the Parks and Recreation Commission.
- Authorized a Joint Powers Agreement for the 15th and Bailey TSS Reduction Project between the Vermillion River Watershed Joint Powers Organization and the City of Hastings.
- Approved the updated 2024-2026 School Resource Officer and Traffic Control Agent Contract.
- Approved an ordinance update to Parklets and Sidewalk Cafes
- Held a first reading to consider amendments to the City Code related to tobacco regulations and licensing fees.
- Heard proposed ordinance language changes to E-Bike regulations.
- Voted to not change ordinance language related to ATV/UTV use on City streets.
- City Administrator Wietecha provided a PFAS update.
