

Marriage Checklist

Reminder

You must provide a copy of your marriage certificate to change ANY benefit.

Your deadline to enroll or make changes is within 30 days of the marriage.

Medical and Dental Plans

What to consider

- Compare your and your new spouse's coverage options.
- Compare your potential out-of-pocket costs: premiums, deductibles, copays and coinsurance.
- Compare prescription drug plans. Are medications you take covered at a higher level under one plan?

What you can do

- Enroll yourself, your new spouse and any eligible dependent children within 30 days of your date of marriage. Coverage is usually effective the date of the marriage.
Note: If you are currently covering your dependents and want to add your new spouse's dependents, you may. However, you must provide a birth certificate for the child(ren) with a different last name.
- Cancel your coverage if you enroll in your new spouse's coverage. Coverage usually ends at the end of the month in which you cancel your coverage.
