- Direct you to local community resources.

How does the program work?

- When you call to enroll in the program, you will need to provide some basic health history and information about your pregnancy.
- After you are enrolled, your maternity nurse specialist will contact you by phone.
- Your maternity nurse specialist will conduct an assessment to determine your needs.
- You will receive a packet of educational information in the mail to help you reduce risk factors for yourself and your unborn child.
- Every three to six weeks, your maternity nurse specialist will contact you to see how you and your baby are progressing. This usually only takes 10 minutes, because we know that you are busy preparing for your new arrival.
- Some pregnancies may require the maternity nurse specialist to be more involved. Your nurse may call more often or send extra materials.

Your phone calls—what to expect

During your phone calls, your nurse will provide support and expert advice on how to have a healthy pregnancy and a healthy baby. Your nurse will:

- Discuss your health history.
- Advise you on safe diet and exercise routines.
- Identify potential pregnancy risk factors.
- O Discuss ways to minimize risks to you and your baby.
- Answer questions and provide written materials on pregnancy and childcare issues that are a concern to you.
- Direct you to available community resources for additional information.

Free resources for you and your baby

In addition to the one-on-one support from your maternity nurse specialist, you will receive—at no cost to you—an educational book with detailed information on pregnancy and caring for an infant. Your nurse may also send additional educational information as needed throughout your pregnancy.
