## City of New Hope Tobacco-Free Policy for City-Owned Property

**Policy:** No person shall use tobacco products in city-owned buildings, vehicles, parkland, park facilities, and open space. This policy is a 24-hour, seven-day per week policy.

**Purpose:** The city of New Hope is committed to the quality of life for all residents, therefore, we believe that:

- Tobacco product use in the proximity of youth and adults is unhealthy and detrimental to the health of others.
- Tobacco products consumed in public spaces are often discarded on the ground, thus posing a risk of ingestion to toddlers and causing a litter problem.

**Exceptions:** The following are exceptions to this policy.

- 1. City Hall, Ice Arena and Golf Course grounds,
- 2. Victory Park Playfields,
- 3. City-owned parking areas,
- 4. As part of a recognized religious/cultural activity or ceremony,
- 5. Special events designated by city staff.

**Implementation:** The emphasis on enforcing the Tobacco-Free Policy is through voluntary compliance.

- 1. Appropriate areas will be signed.
- 2. The community will be notified about this policy through city publications and on the city web site.
- 3. City staff will make periodic observations of facilities and parkland to monitor for compliance.
