Introducing a new prescription

Questions to ask your veterinarian about any new prescription medications:

- · What does the medication do?
- When and how do I administer it to my pet?
- What signs suggest a potential adverse reaction?
- What can I do if I miss or give too much of a dose?
- Are there alternatives to the medication?



Pet prescription safety tips

Keep your pets safe by being mindful with their medicines.

- Keep all medications out of reach from your pets
- · Never use one pet's medication for another pet
- Always finish your pet's medication (unless otherwise instructed by your veterinarian)
- If you observe signs of an adverse reaction or worsening condition, contact your veterinarian immediately



Tell your veterinarian about all over-the-counter medications and supplements your pet is taking.
