Health Insurance Renewal

We recently received our 2024 renewal rates for the City's health insurance. An increase is expected each year, however, this year's renewal rate came back much higher than we anticipated. We received a 23.3% renewal rate for 2024. This increase will understandably have an impact on you and your family. We are looking at all options to bring costs down and find alternatives.

On September 11, we held an all-staff meeting to review the renewal and what our options are for 2024. Here are the key considerations:

- Why are we experiencing this kind of increase? There are many factors that are converging at this time. The largest factor is increased claims (see pages 3-4) and a consortium structural overhaul for long-term viability. We have experienced no or relatively low increases over the past few years (see page 5).
- The current plan will continue to be offered at the new rate (with the plan change to the HSA deductible as required federally). See the current plan and renewal rates on page 6 of the attached PDF.
- To reduce premiums, we are also considering other options:

- narrower network—see pages 8-9
- plan alternatives (copay/coinsurance)—see pages 10-12
- go outside the consortium—see pages 14-16; as discussed, due to the renewal timeframe, this may not be prudent for 2024, but will be a critical task for an employee committee in 2024.
- **FEEDBACK and TIMELINE**: We have scheduled Open Enrollment for November 1-15. To assemble plan options that meet your needs, we need your feedback. If you have not already done so, let us know what your thoughts are after you review these materials by completing the survey by Friday, September 22. There are envelopes in each building in which to return the survey.

The City of Hastings is a member of a county-wide group that partners with Dakota Communications Center (DCC) for services. One of those services includes Everbridge Emergency Alerts. When a serious safety emergency happens in our area, our Public Safety responders will assess the situation and determine whether or not people in the surrounding area need to be alerted to a safety issue. If needed, they can request that an Everbridge Alert be sent out to a broad area, or a smaller, targeted area based on the threat assessment.
